

BUS TRIP TO THE HOLIDAY TRAIN SHOW AT THE NY BOTANICAL GARDEN

See more than 175 New York landmarks, each re-created with bark, leaves, and other natural materials—all under the twinkling glow of the Haupt Conservatory. Marvel at G-scale locomotives humming past familiar sights as the Brooklyn Bridge and Rockefeller Center on nearly a half-mile of track. This year's exhibition showcases Lower Manhattan, featuring the Statue of Liberty, Ellis Island, One World Trade Center, and the Battery Maritime Building along with two vintage ferry boats.



The bus will leave the Rt.33 & Wm Penn Park 'n' Ride at 9 a.m. A guide will meet us and take us on a guided tour of the exhibit. At 1 p.m., we will dine in the Garden Terrace Room. A box lunch is included in the price; choices are Italian ham/salami/cheese on a baguette, tomato and mozzarella on a sourdough baguette, or a grilled chicken Cobb salad plus a piece of fruit, potato chips, chocolate chip cookies, and bottled water.

After lunch, we'll have free time to explore the winter wonderland trees, listen to an a cappella choir, or revisit the exhibit. For families, there is a variety of children's activities.

Departure is at 5 p.m. with estimated arrival in Easton at 7 p.m. Price is \$105 per person and includes transportation and gratuity, all tour and admission fees, and lunch.
